- <sup>23</sup>And having sent the people away, he went up the mountain by himself to pray. At nightfall, he was there alone. <sup>24</sup>Meanwhile, the boat was very far from land, dangerously rocked by the waves for the wind was against it.
- $^{25}$ At daybreak, Jesus came to them walking on the lake.  $^{26}$ When they saw him walking on the sea, they were terrified, thinking that it was a ghost. And they cried out in fear.  $^{27}$ But at once Jesus said to them:
  - —Courage! Don't be afraid. It's me!
  - <sup>28</sup>Peter answered:
  - —Lord, if it is you, command me to come to you walking on the water.
  - <sup>29</sup>Jesus said to him:
  - —Come.

And Peter got out of the boat, walking on the water to go to Jesus. <sup>30</sup>But, in face of the strong wind, he was afraid and began to sink. So he cried out:
