## Mission of the disciples

<sup>16</sup>As for the Eleven disciples, they went to Galilee, to the mountain where Jesus had told them to go.  
<sup>17</sup>When they saw Jesus, they bowed before him, although some doubted.

<sup>18</sup>Then Jesus approached them and said:

—I have been given all authority in heaven and on earth. <sup>19</sup>Go, therefore, and make disciples from all nations. Baptize them in the Name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, <sup>20</sup>and teach them to fulfill all that I have commanded you. I am with you always until the end of this world.

The other gospels have their own interpretation of these events and have their own particularities as well. We have chosen the most representative of each one, and in the passages that are common we have chosen those that have a special characteristic.
