Jesus being tested

4 ¹Then the Spirit led Jesus into the desert that he be put to the test by the devil. ²After spending forty days and nights without food, Jesus was hungry. ³Then the devil came to him and said:

—If you are the Son of God, order these stones to turn into bread.

4 But Jesus answered:

—Scripture says: *one does not live on bread alone, but on every word that comes from the mouth of God.*

5 Then the devil took Jesus to the holy city, set him on the highest wall of the temple, and said to him:

—If you are the Son of God, throw yourself down, for scripture says, *God has given orders to his angels about you. Their hands will hold you up lest you hurt your foot against a stone.*

7 Jesus answered:

—But scripture also says: *You shall not put to the test the Lord your God.*

8 Then the devil took Jesus to a very high mountain and showed him all the nations of the world in all their greatness and splendor. And he said:

9 —All this I will give you, if you kneel and worship me. **10** Then Jesus answered:

—Be off, Satan! Scripture says: *worship the Lord your God and serve him alone.*

11 Then the devil left him, and angels came to serve him.
